New Business

A. Tax update: Despite 95% of the Newton county property tax monies being collected, our income is drastically lower than expected. In 2019 the whole county assessed valuation was 809 million. In 2020 it was 723 million, a drastic decrease without any correlating factors. In 2021 it was increased to 870 million, which reflected an enormous amount of growth from 20-21, causing our tax rate to be significantly rolled back. In 2020 we received \$723,000 in property tax income. This year we are supposed to receive \$734,000. When Carrie went to the Newton County courthouse to inquire as to why our income was lower than expected, no adequate answers were provided. We decided as a

board to contact Nicole Galloway, the state auditor, to request an audit of the county finances as they pertain to our property tax income.

The motion to adjourn open session was made by Rick and seconded by Phyllis. The vote was unanimous to adjourn.
