Six Hundred Attend Open House

CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW BUILDING STARTED JULY 5, 1955, AND IT WAS READY FOR OCCUPANCY JANUARY 18, 1956. OPEN HOUSE, WITH APPROXIMATELY 600 IN ATTENDANCE, WAS HELD ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 22, WITH THE GRADE STUDENTS BEING TRANSFERRED THE NEXT DAY.

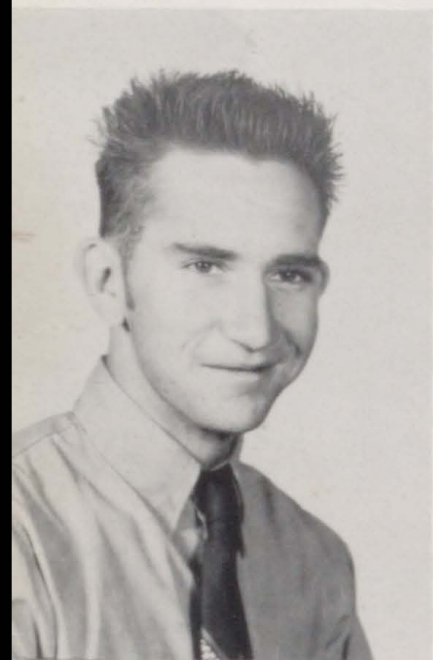
Seniors Proud of School's Progress
