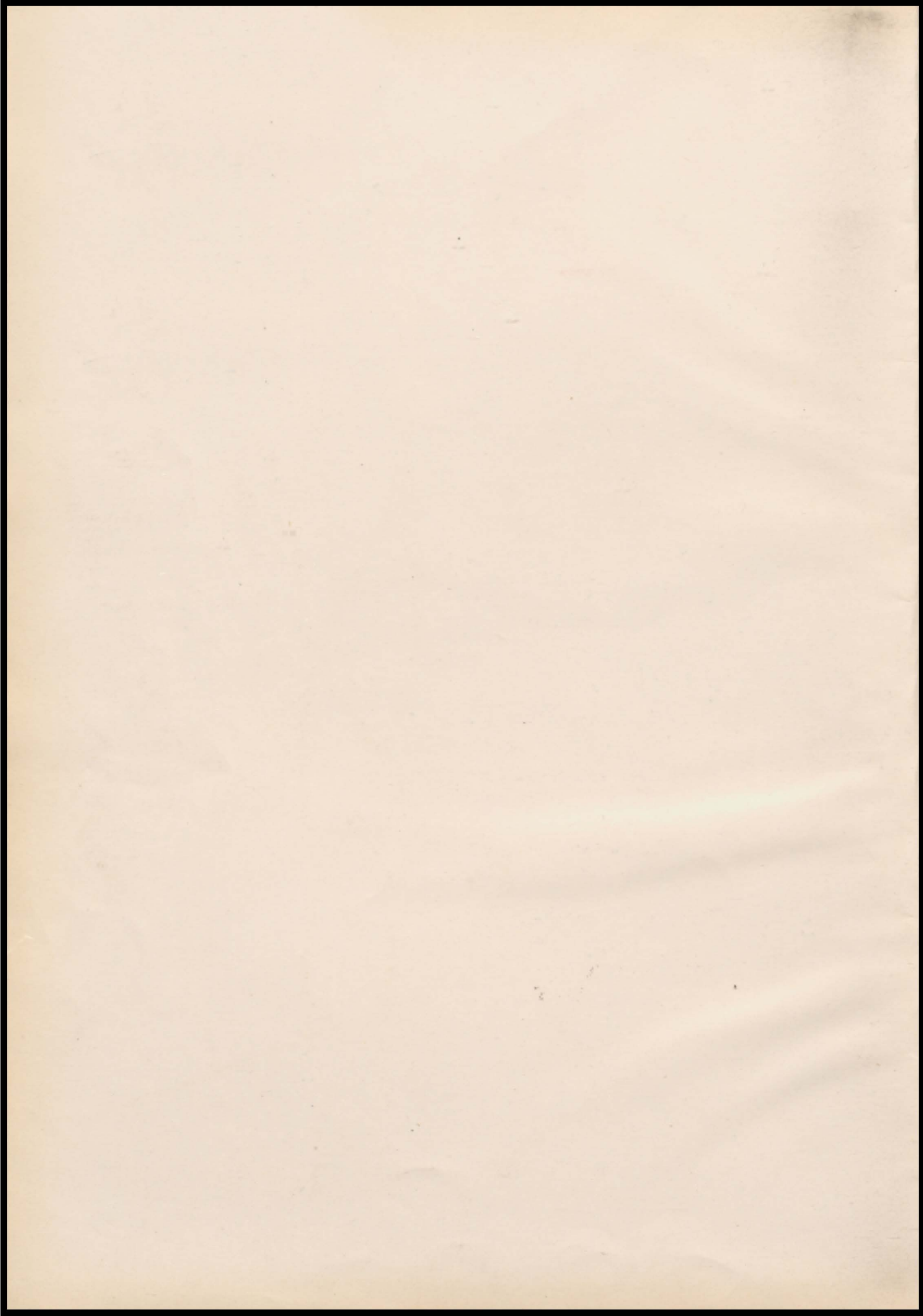

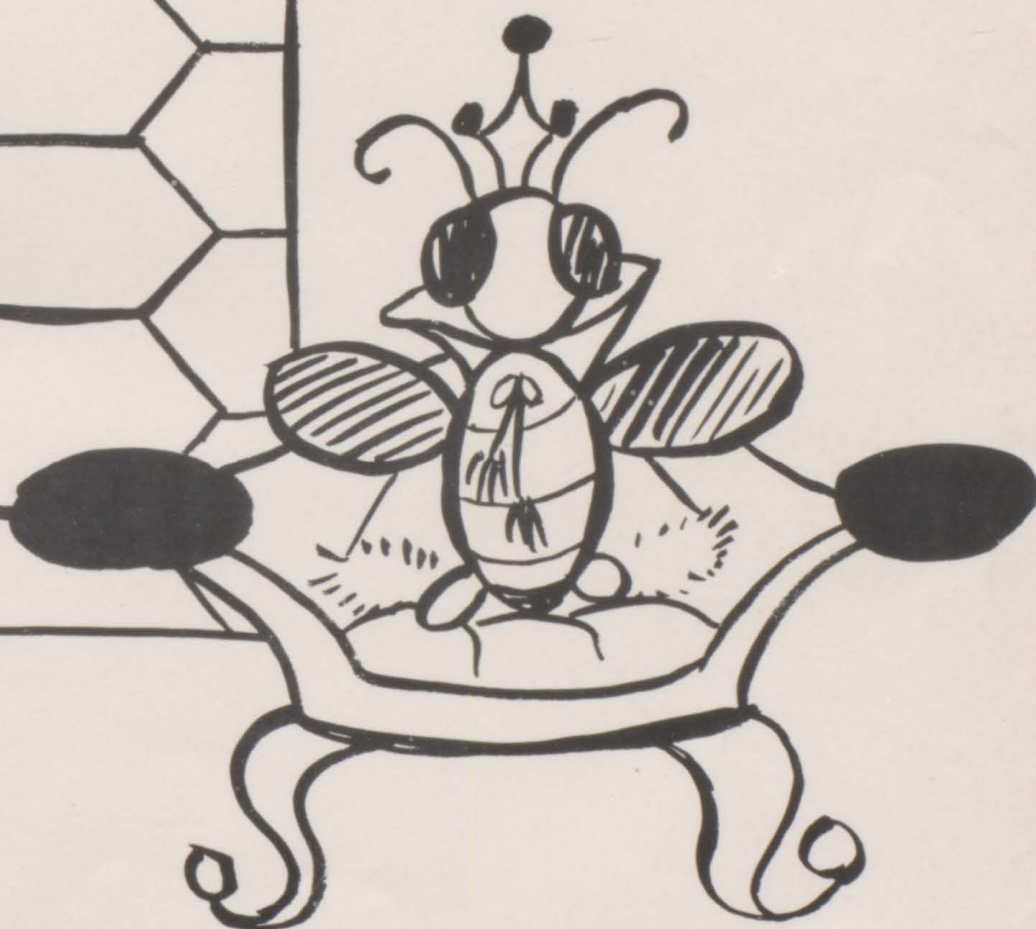
She understood the aching hearts of those

     night.

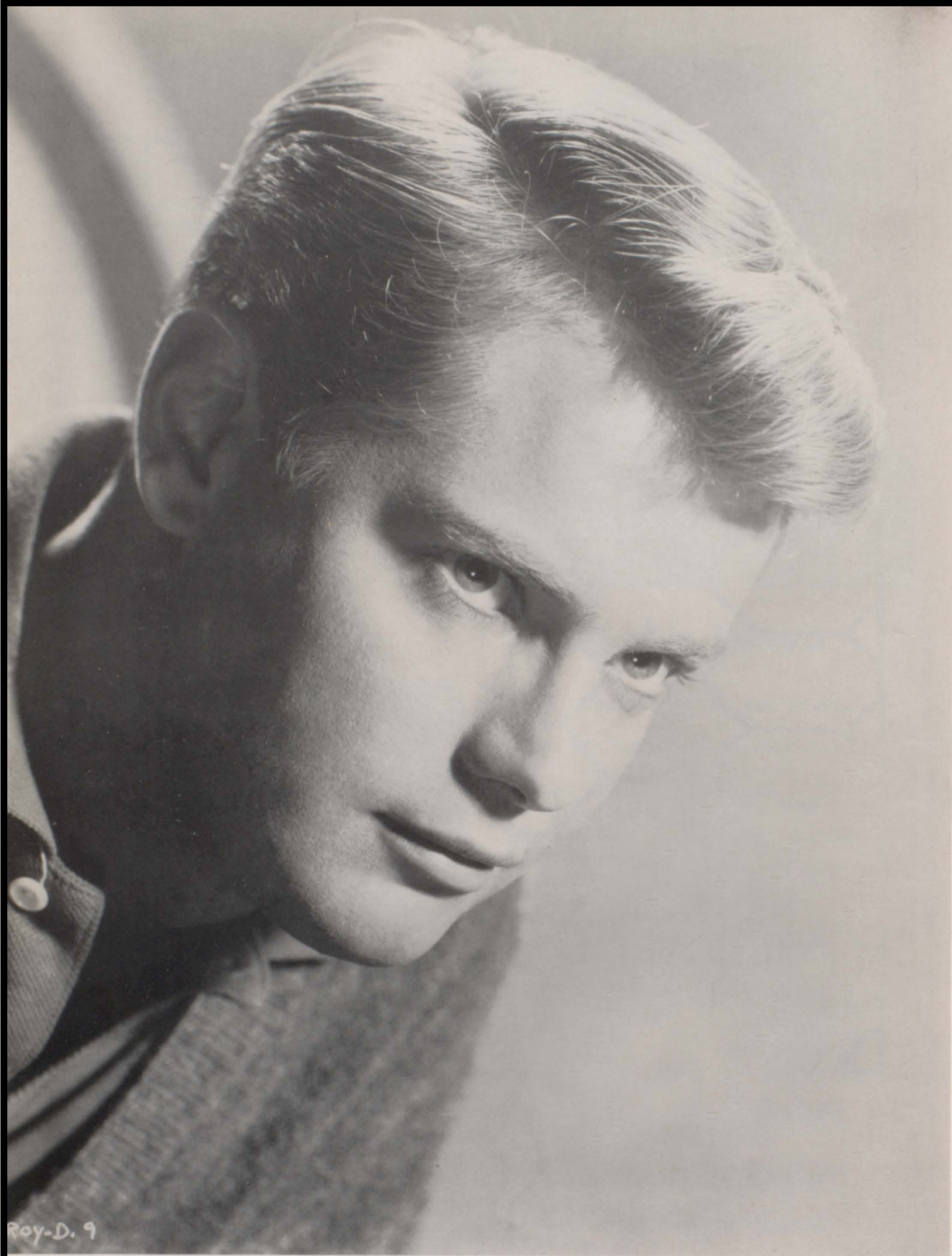

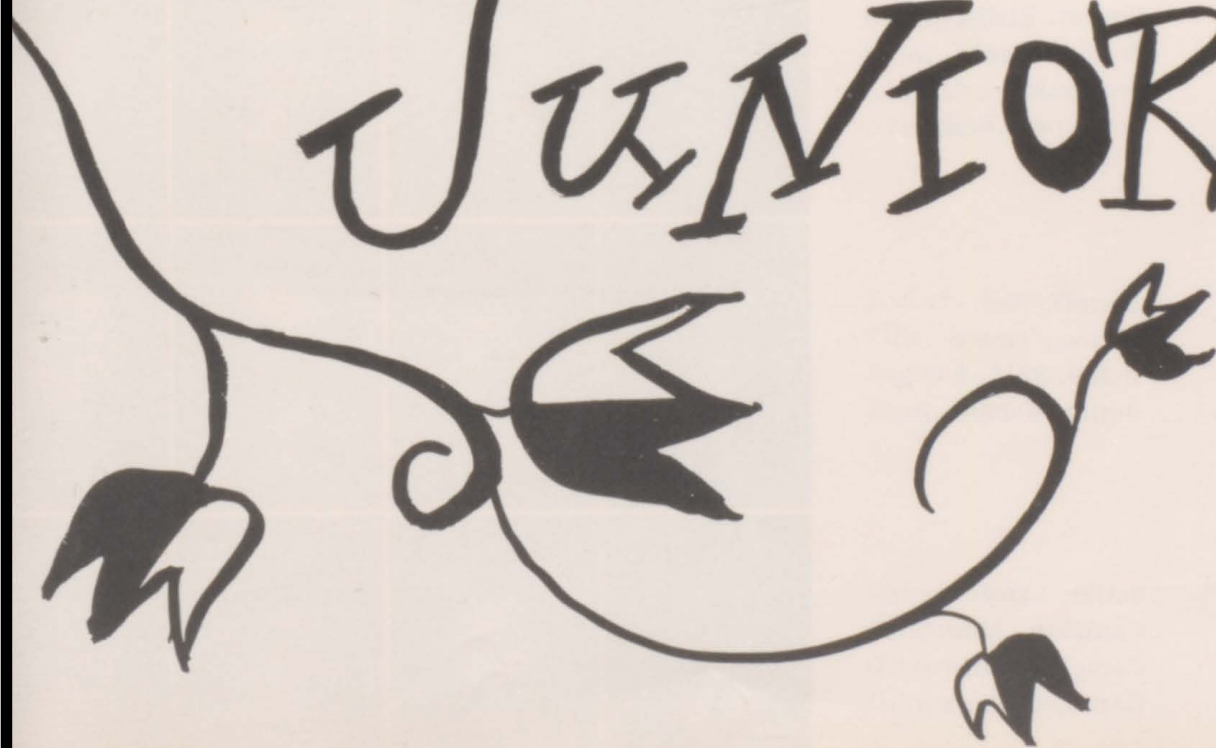
In mid-October, our high school sponsored a project, from which all reports, to the participants was a great success.
